3. Foreign Exchange Market

The peso closed 6 and ½ centavos stronger at P48.570 to the dollar on Tuesday (April 6) against Monday's P48.635. Today, it opened at P48.530 reaching a high of P48.520 slid to a low of P48.550 and an average of P48.542 with transaction volume of \$121.80 million as of 10:30 A.M.
