3. Foreign Exchange Market

The peso closed 5 and ½ centavos stronger at P49.865 to the dollar on Friday (September 10) against Thursday's P49.920. Today, it opened at P49.970 reaching a high of P49.950 slid to a low of P50.070 and an average of P50.005 with a total transaction volume of \$843.45 million.
