Volume of GS traded based on Bloomberg Valuation, Wednesday (December 15) was higher at P24,935.01M against Tuesday’s P18,346.74M. Of this, P5,717.05M (22.93%) was for t-bonds, P8,327.34M (33.40%) RTBs and P10,890.62M (43.68%) for t-bills.

3. Foreign Exchange Market

The peso closed 8 centavos stronger at P50.270 to the dollar on Wednesday (December 15) against Tuesday’s P50.350. Today, it opened at P50.200 reaching a high of P49.960 slid to a low of P50.220 and an average of P50.135 with a total transaction volume of \$826.63 million.
