RESOLUTION NO. 45 - 2022

**DECLARING THE LOWEST CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BIDDER (LCRB)
FOR THE SUPPLY OF LABOR, MATERIALS, TOOLS/EQUIPMENT AND
PROFESSIONAL SUPERVISION FOR THE AUGMENTATION OF
THE SECURITY SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM OF THE
AYUNTAMIENTO BUILDING (RE-BID)**

WHEREAS, the Bureau of the Treasury (BTr), through the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), invited prospective bidders to apply for eligibility and to bid for the Supply of Labor, Materials, Tools/Equipment and Professional Supervision for the Augmentation of the Security Surveillance System of the Ayuntamiento Building (Re-Bid) with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of Three Million Six Hundred Thirty Six Thousand Three Hundred Twenty Pesos (PHP3,636,320.00), inclusive of all applicable taxes;

WHEREAS, on August 11, 2022, the Invitation to Bid (ITB) was posted in the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and BTr website;

WHEREAS, on August 19, 2022, six (6) prospective bidders, namely, 1) Faxcable, Inc., 2) Maxcore Technologies, Inc, 3) Stage Craft International, Inc., 4) DGL Veracity Systems Corporation, 5) Pronet Systems Integrated Network Solution, Inc. and 6) RTM Trade, Inc. attended the Pre-bid Conference;

WHEREAS, on September 1, 2022, five (5) bidders, namely, 1) Stage Craft International, Inc., 2) Faxcable, Inc., 3) Worksystems, Inc., 4) Infobahn Communications, Inc. and 5) DGL Veracity Systems Corporation bought the bidding documents and submitted their Technical and Financial Bids, however, Stage Craft International, Inc. was disqualified due to its non-compliance with the requirement under the Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC), while, Worksystems, Inc. was also disqualified due to its failure to comply with the requirement under Section VI. Schedule of Requirements, therefore, only the bids of Faxcable, Inc., Infobahn Communications, Inc. and DGL Veracity Systems Corporation were opened, read and calculated;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No 24 - 2022 dated September 1, 2022, the BAC declared Faxcable, Inc. as the Lowest Calculated Bidder (LCB) and was subjected to Post-Qualification;

WHEREAS, upon careful examination, validation and verification of all statements made and the legal, technical, and financial documents submitted by Faxcable, Inc.: the same was declared as non-responsive for its failure to meet the minimum requirement specified in the Technical Specifications as contained in the

Bidding Documents; thereafter the second lowest calculated bidder (DGL Veracity Systems Corporation) was subjected to post qualification;

WHEREAS, a Notice of Post-Disqualification was issued to Faxcable, Inc on November 16, 2022, wherein a Motion for Reconsideration was received on November 21, 2022, which on 28 November 2022, the BAC finally resolved to deny said Motion for Reconsideration.

WHEREAS, on December 19, 2022, the Technical Working Group (TWG) submitted its post qualification report, finding the Bid of DGL Veracity Systems Corporation as responsive;

WHEREAS, upon careful examination, validation and verification of all statements made and the legal, technical, financial documents submitted by DGL Veracity Systems Corporation, the BAC found their bid responsive and thereafter, declared as the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bidder (LCRB);

NOW THEREFORE, the Bids and Awards Committee **RESOLVED**, as it hereby **RESOLVES** to:

- a. declare DGL Veracity Systems Corporation as the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bidder (LCRB) for the Supply of Labor, Materials, Tools/Equipment and Professional Supervision for the Augmentation of the Security Surveillance System of the Ayuntamiento Building (Re-Bid);
- b. recommend the award for the Supply of Labor, Materials, Tools/Equipment and Professional Supervision for the Augmentation of the Security Surveillance System of the Ayuntamiento Building (Re-Bid) for the Contract Price of Three Million Four Hundred Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PHP3,403,500.00), inclusive of all applicable taxes; and
- c. recommend for the approval of the Treasurer of the Philippines as Head of the Procuring Entity (HOPE) the foregoing findings.
