TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF EIGHT HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE (861) PIECES OF BUREAU OF TREASURY MAGNETIC LAPEL PINS

I. Background

The Bureau of the Treasury (BTr) intends to procure 861 pieces of magnetic lapel pins for the employees and officials of the Bureau of the Treasury as part of the Bureau's 127th founding anniversary.

II. Objectives

This project aims to procure high-quality magnetic lapel pins that meet the specified design, materials, and durability standards, ensuring it can be used effectively by the employees of the Bureau of the Treasury.

III. Approved Budget of the Contract

The approved budget of the contract (ABC) is **One Hundred Seventy-Two Thousand Two Hundred Pesos (Php 172,200.00)**, inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees.

IV. Scope of Work:

The winning bidder is expected to:

- Design, manufacture, and deliver 861 pieces of magnetic lapel pins with BTr logo.
- Ensure that the design follows the approved specifications provided by the Bureau of the Treasury.
- Use durable materials that meet the quality requirements stated in this technical specifications.
- Deliver the final product to the Bureau of the Treasury – Central Office, Ayuntamiento Building, Cabildo St., Intramuros, Manila within the 30 calendar days upon receipt of **approved actual sample of magnetic lapel pin.**

V. Technical Specifications

The magnetic lapel pins shall meet the following specifications:

- Material:** Metal with gold finish; Logo – raised gold metal
- Overall Size:** 0.75 inches diameter

- c. **Personalization Area:** Center Seal, embossed Eagle and Philippine Flag logo in gold metal; and embossed Bureau of the Treasury in dye blue raised
- d. **Thickness:** 1.5 mm
- e. **Shape:** Circle
- f. **Attachment:** Magnetic back, strong enough to hold the pin securely on clothing without causing damage.
- g. **Packaging:** Each pin should be individually packed in a protective pouch or gift box.
