

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF EIGHT HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE (861) PIECES OF LEATHER DESK MAT WITH BTR LOGO

I. Background

The Bureau of the Treasury (BTr) intends to procure 861 pieces Leather Desk Mat with BTr Logo for the employees and officials of the Bureau of the Treasury as part of the Bureau's 127th founding anniversary.

II. Objectives

This project aims to procure high-quality desk mat that meet the specified design, materials, and durability standards, ensuring it can be used effectively by the employees of the Bureau of the Treasury.

III. Approved Budget of the Contract

The approved budget of the contract (ABC) is Nine Hundred Ninety Thousand One Hundred Fifty Pesos (Php 990,150.00), inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees.

IV. Scope of Work:

The winning bidder is expected to:

- a. Design, manufacture, and deliver 861 pieces of leather desk mat with BTr logo.
- b. Ensure that the design follows the approved specifications provided by the Bureau of the Treasury.
- c. Use durable materials that meet the quality requirements stated in this technical specifications.
- d. Deliver the final product to the Bureau of the Treasury Central Office. Ayuntamiento Building, Cabildo St., Intramuros, Manila within the 30 calendar days from the approval of actual sample desk mat.

V. Technical Specifications


The leather desk mat shall meet the following specifications:

- a. Material: PU Leather
- b. Overall Dimension: 90cm x 45cm (36" x 18")
- c. Personalization Area: with debossed BTr Logo at the bottom left corner of desk mat



- d. Thickness: 0.50mm
- e. **Shape:** Rectangular curved corner
- f. **Logo:** Official logo of the Bureau of the Treasury; debossed at the lower left corner of desk mat
