TERMS OF REFERENCE

Provision of Venue Including Food and Accommodation for the Conduct of the GFPS Project Implementation Management and Monitoring Evaluation (PIMME)

Workshop

I. Objective

The Treasurer of the Philippines of the Bureau of the Treasury (BTr) directed and authorized the officials and employees comprising the members of the Gender and Development Focal Point System (GFPS), to attend and participate in the GFPS Project Implementation Management and Monitoring Evaluation (PIMME) Workshop, to be held on 22-25 January 2025 (inclusive of travel time). The workshop aims to enhance the Bureau's Gender and Development (GAD) Plan and Budget (GPB) to achieve the budget requirements as mandated by law and prepare the GAD Accomplishment Report (AR).

The purpose of this procurement is to lease a venue for the said activity, including the food and accommodation, from a conference or hotel facility within Baguio City.

V. Mode of Procurement

VI. Payment Scheme

Full payment shall be made after receipt of the Billing Statement from the supplier.

VII. Liquidated Damages

Failure to comply with the Terms and Conditions of the contract will result in the payment of corresponding penalties/ liquidated damages in the amount equal to one-tenth of one percent (1%) of the cost of unperformed portion for every day of delay. If the cumulative amount of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%) of the contract, the BTr reserves the right to rescind the contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies open to it.
